# Information for Landowners:

Landholders can expect to pay the following cost-share fees for services:

- \$ 25 per site visit
- \$125 per dam removed

Initial damage assessment is provided at no charge.

Beaver management specialists average 10 visits over a 30-day period to resolve the problem. Landholders willing to conduct beaver management activities themselves are provided individual training at no cost.
