# **Information for Landowners:**

**Landholders can expect to pay the following cost-share fees for services:**

- **\$ 25 per site visit**
- **\$125 per dam removed**

**Initial damage assessment is provided at no charge.**

**Beaver management specialists average 10 visits over a 30-day period to resolve the problem. Landholders willing to conduct beaver management activities themselves are provided individual training at no cost.**
